



**INVITATIONAL FOR BB GUN, AIR RIFLE, AIR PISTOL
 FEBRUARY 13, 2010
 HAVENSVILLE, KANSAS
 Havensville School Gym - Located Off of Highway 63**

The 4-H Straight Shooters will be hosting an invitational for BB Gun, Air Rifle and Air Pistol. This invitational will be a state qualifier. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from age 7 to 18. We will have a division for 1st year shooters and for shooters over 1 year as stated below under each discipline. (NOTE: the minimum age to participate at the State Match is 9 as of Jan. 1, 2010 but we will allow younger ages - see breakdown below).

Registration needs to be turned in by February 1, 2010 by mail, fax or email on the attached form. Cost is \$10 per shooter per discipline. We will only accept registration from one person per county and this person will be notified of relay times. Each county should have at least 1 scorer for each discipline to help with scoring. The registration will begin at 7:30 a.m. and **each county needs to verify their shooters information when checking in the day of the match for correct age and discipline group.**

Award medals will be given as stated below. Each shooter will receive a certificate of participation.

BB GUN relays will be at 8:00 a.m., 9:00 a.m., 10:00 a.m. and 11 a.m. (limit is 16 per relay). Shooters will shoot 10 bull shots in each of the 4 positions on the AR4/10 (2005) targets and will follow the NRA BB Gun 5 meter rule book.. Individual medals will be given to the top 3 shooters in prone, standing, sitting, kneeling, and total aggregate in the following age groups. The team will be the top 5 shooters from each county and the top 3 teams will be awarded. To qualify for State Match in BB gun, the minimum individual score is 275.

AIR RIFLE relays will be at 12:00 noon and 2:00 p.m. (limit is 16 per relay). Shooters will shoot 20 bull shots in each of the 3 positions on the NRA 10-meter target AR5/10 targets and will follow the CMP 10 meter air rifle rule book. Individual medals will be given to the top 3 shooters in prone, standing, kneeling, and total aggregate in the following age groups. The team will be the top 4 shooters from each county and the top 3 teams will be awarded. To qualify for the State Match in air rifle, the minimum individual score is 350.

AIR PISTOL relay will be at 3:00 p.m.. (limit is 16). This is a paper match only on B-40 targets and will follow the NRA B-40 air pistol rule book and each shooter will shoot 4 targets (5 shots per target). There will be no bench rests. Individual medals will be given to the top 3 shooters in total aggregate in the following age groups. Team will be the top 2 senior air pistol shooters from each county and the top 3 teams will be awarded. To qualify for the State Match in air pistol, the minimum individual score is 100.
