

## 4-H Photography Special Recognition Selections

A number of Kansas 4-H Photographs will be selected for recognition and/or further display after State Fair. Photographs selected will be marked with a special sticker stating the recognition. Photos will be collected and kept the last day of State Fair.

**To be eligible for selection for further display, the Photo Release Statement on the Kansas State Fair 4-H Photography ID form, must be completed and signed.**

### Selected from the purple photographs.

1. **Washington DC Display:**

Thirty photographs will be selected for display in the Offices of the Kansas Senators and Representatives. The photos will be framed and on display in the Senator's or Representative's office for a year. Photos will be presented to the Senators and Representatives during National 4-H Conference (late March, 2015). The photos will be returned upon completion of the display period, (March 2015 to March 2016).

2. **Rock Springs Display:**

Thirty-five 4-H photographs will be selected for display in Heritage Hall at Rock Springs 4-H Center. The photos will be on display for a year and enjoyed by more than 25,000 visitors to Rock Springs. The photographs may also be used for special projects as determined by the State 4-H Photo Action Team, State 4-H Department or the Kansas 4-H Foundation. The photos will be returned after the 2015 Kansas State Fair

3. **Kansas Governor's Display:**

Five photographs will be selected for display in the Offices of the Kansas Governor. Photographs will be presented to the Kansas Governor during 4-H Citizenship in Action and returned at the end of the display period (February 2015 to February 2016).

4. **Kansas State University President's Display:**

Five photographs will be selected for display in the Office of the President of Kansas State University. Photos will be presented to the President winter of 2014/15 and returned at the end of the display period (late 2015 to early 2016).

5. **Kansas State University Dean of Agriculture Display:**

Five photographs will be selected for display in the Office of the Dean of Agriculture, Kansas State University. Photos will be presented to the Dean late fall 2014 or early winter 2015 and returned at the end of the display period (early 2016).

### Selected from All photographs.

1. **Kansas 4-H Foundation Publication Award:**

The Kansas 4-H Foundation will select a number of exhibits for possible publication throughout 2014 - 2016. These photos may be featured in the Kansas 4-H Journal, the Kansas 4-H Calendar, the annual report and/or various other publications. Will be returned following the 2015 State Fair.

2. **Kansas 4-H Traveling Photography Collection:**

One photo from each county will be selected by the Photo Action Team to be included in the Kansas 4-H Traveling Photography collection. Will be returned following the 2015 State Fair.

4. **Sunflower Award:**

Twenty to twenty-five photos representing one or more aspects of composition will be selected by 4-H Photography Action Team Teen Leaders for the Sunflower Award. Criteria for selection includes, but is not limited to, lighting, action, attention-grabber, pleasing to the eye, use of color, black and white contrast and leading lines. The selected photos will be identified by a sunflower sticker. Photos will be returned at the end of 2013 State Fair (not retained for further display).

5. **Additional recognition selections:**

Gordon Parks Award for best black and white.
