The Conference is next weekend October 18-19 at Rock Springs 4H Center. Here's what you need to know before you go:

• Check-in for Dog Conference as well as vet check for your dog is at Johnson Administration Building.

 After check-in, you will need to take your things to your cabin. Lunch will be served at noon. The first session will be at the Activity Center behind the Dining Hall. All other sessions are in Lower Level of Heritage Hall.

Bring bedding (sleeping bag, sheets, or other bedding of your preference), pillows, towels, and toiletries.

Bring a flashlight.

• Wear good walking shoes and weather-appropriate clothing.

You will receive a program at check-in.

- If you registered for the photography contest, bring your mounted photos. Photos should be mounted per <u>Kansas State Fair 4-H Photography rules</u>. \*Note, photos should be mounted, but not in a sleeve/bag.

 Bring your camera or other device for photos of tails on the trails and to participate in the photography session.

If you're bringing your dog:

- All dogs attending must have a CURRENT immunization record <u>MG34 Kansas 4-H</u> <u>Dog Show Immunization Record (ksu.edu)</u>
- All dogs must be in a kennel in the cabins. No dogs are allowed on the furniture or beds.
- o ONLY service dogs are allowed in the Dining Hall.
- o Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- Dogs in season are not allowed.
- o Puppies younger than 6 months of age are not allowed.
- The evening activities include a costume contest. Bring costumes for you and your dog.
- o Bring bags to clean up after your dog.
