

Campference Dress Code

As you are preparing for Campference and packing your suit case, we would like for you to remember you are representing your county or district as a 4-H member. Your peers and other delegates will be looking to you for an example. A good rule of thumb is to wear what you would be pleased to be seen in, fits your personality, and reflects well on you as a Kansas 4-Her.

We ask you to plan your wardrobe accordingly by following this dress code:

Items of clothing advertising alcoholic beverages, tobacco products or drugs, or that have vulgar, obscene or offensive messages **are not appropriate.**

Undergarments should be worn but not seen.

Hats, caps, and visors are not appropriate inside buildings and at meals.

Shorts should be appropriate for school (Example: 3-5 inch inseam)

Shirts, blouses, tops and t-shirts cannot expose the midriff, the back, or cleavage.

Tank tops and tops with spaghetti straps are allowed as long as they are not revealing.

See through shirts are not acceptable

Modest Swimsuits are appropriate, no thong or skimpy bikini swimsuits are allowed.

When leaving the swimming pool area all youth must have a shirt and shoes on.

All wardrobes are subject to approval of adults in charge.
