Open to all Kansas 4-H club members enrolled in the 2024 4-H Dog Project

SHOW RULES:

- 1. Any 4-H member who is enrolled in the 2024 4-H Dog Project and has trained his own dog with the assistance from a leader is eligible to compete.
- 2. All dogs must be <u>six months</u> of age or older at date of show to enter. No dog in season will be allowed to show.
- 3. A copy of current vaccinations **MUST ACCOMPANY** your entry. Rabies must be signed by veterinarian, the "Kansas 4-H dog show immunization record".
- 4. There will be three classes of competition, which will be Showmanship (determined by 4-Hers age) and Obedience and Rally O (determined by dog's training experience). All will be open to mixed breeds and purebred dogs. In obedience, a dog may be entered in only <u>one</u> class. In Showmanship and Rally O, a dog may be entered in different classes if shared by family member. This would be a different team combination of dog and 4-H member.
- 5. In Obedience and Rally O, entries may be made in a higher classification, but cannot regress in future competitions. For example, if a qualifying score (blue or purple) in Pre-Novice is received under two different judges with the 4-H year (October 1- September 30) you will automatically move up to the Novice class the <u>next year</u>.
- 6. The exhibitor is expected to handle, groom, and exercise their dog at the show. If others are doing this for the 4-Her, a disqualification could result.
- 7. Show rules will follow the guidelines of the <u>Kansas 4-H Dog Show Rules revised 2023</u> https://bookstore.ksre.ksu.edu/pubs/4H1120.pdf.
- 8. Any dog showing excessive aggression or attacking another dog or person on the show grounds will be asked to leave immediately.
- 9. The Sedgwick County Extension Service will not be responsible for any loss, theft, injury or death of dogs or people while on the premises.
- 10. All dogs must be exercised prior to entering the ring. Any dog fouling the ring will receive a white ribbon.
- 11. NO DOGS ALLOWED IN THE RING BEFORE CLASS.
- 12. No grooming equipment, toys, or treats allowed in the ring.
- 13. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times except when competing in "off leash" competition.
- 14. The following <u>disqualifications where NO RIBBON</u> would be given for classes of showmanship, obedience, and agility:
 - A. Dogs/handlers dismissed from ring by judge due to:
 - (1) Dog leaving ring or out of control
 - (2) Dog being overly aggressive
 - (3) Handler using abusive language or unsportsmanlike conduct
 - B. Baiting dogs with food, toys or electronic devices
