Saturday after the speaker, there will be workshops, time with 4-H Staff and new ideas. End the day with the Annual Meeting of the KA4H-VA and silent auction.

Sunday morning includes more opportunities for learning including Lightening Rounds.

Friday evening is optional, get acquainted, learn more about KA4-HV, participate in a service project, enjoy some social interaction or some down time at beautiful Rock Springs.

Registration and Fees

The Kansas 4-H Volunteer Forum is open to all 4-H Volunteers. All Kansas 4-H Volunteer Forum participants will register through the Kansas Leadership Weekend participant registration site. An adult who is chaperoning KYLF may be housed in the cabins with the KYLF delegates or with the Volunteer Forum. You will indicate your preference during registration. KYLF Chaperones can attend the Volunteer Forum

\$165 (Early Bird Fee, register on or before October 15) \$190 (Regular Fee register from October 16 to November 1) Includes: Saturday morning through Sunday lunch: lodging, meals, snacks, insurance, program fees and Volunteer Forum t-shirt. KYLF t-shirts will be available for \$18 extra, order when registering. Delegates should pay fees to their local Extension Office. Optional: You can add Friday night lodging and breakfast to your registration for \$65.

Registration is on-line. All online registrations are contingent upon your Extension Agent's approval and your fee being turned in on time. If you cancel on or before November 1, you will be subject to a \$25 cancellation fee. If you cancel after November 1, you will not receive your registration fee back and will be expected to pay the entire fee.

Lifetime KA4-HV members qualify for a [\\$25](#) scholarship (net cost [\\$140](#) or [\\$165](#)). Use the coupon code "KA4-HV" to get the scholarship. You may pay your dues ([\\$50](#) lifetime) at the Forum and qualify for the scholarship.

Dress for Volunteer Forum is camp business casual. Plan to dress for the weather at Rock Springs including bringing a warm jacket or sweatshirt. Participants should bring toiletry and personal care items, and may want a flashlight. Bedding and towels will be provided for those housed with the Forum in Leadership Lodge. Please bring your best ideas and activities to share. You may also want to bring a silent auction item and/or bingo prize.
