We are particularly looking for new and exciting virtual lessons to give KYLF a fresh workshop selection.

Please consider offering the topic during both class times. Presentations that involve the audience and have some type of handout have been the most effective in past years.

If you know of others who would be good presenters or facilitators, please share this information with them as well. The Youth Council will be reviewing proposals in September. Selected presenters will be notified nearly September. Additional information will be sent to presenters prior to the Forum.
