**UPDATE: Sporting Clays will shoot 100 targets to align with National Championships. Trap and Skeet will remain at 50 targets for 2021. Youth must qualify in either Trap or Skeet in order to shoot Sporting Clays.**

- Cvent Registration
  - 4-H Shooting Sports Coordinators should collect all individual and team information, including shirt information, for each discipline.
  - Coordinators and/or Extension 4-H agents will register individual and team information for their District or County.
  - **Entries are due Thursday, September 2 at 11:59 PM.**
  - All checks must be sent to the State 4-H Office and postmarked by September 23.
  - Shotgun shells will be available to purchase for any program/family that is unable to source their own shells. Contact Cody Woelk, Shotgun Steering Group Chairperson, directly at 620-376-8381 to arrange quantity prior to October 9.
    - All shells purchased must be used at the State Match.
- Day Check-In & Equipment Check
  - Participants must check in on time.
  - Coaches will confirm teams at Check-In.
    - Teams must be consistent for all disciplines. (i.e. no switching team members between trap team and skeet team)
  - Youth relay times will be sent to Coordinators prior to match day.
- Participation Requirements
  - Youth participants must be 10 years of age to participate.
  - All ages are determined before January 1, 2021.
  - All youth participants must be enrolled in Shotgun.
  - All youth must be participants in a Certified Kansas 4-H Shooting Sports Program at the county or district level.

- All participants are required to participate in a sanctioned qualifying match and have received a minimum score of:
  - Trap: 35 points out of 50 possible
  - Skeet: 30 points out of 50 possible
  - Sporting Clays: Shooter must qualify in either trap or skeet
- Shooting Sports Shirt Order Process
  - Shirts will be ordered within CVent state match registration- have youth/adult sizes and quantities available.
  - Shirts Youth S- Adult XL will cost \$16. 2XL and up will be \$18.50.
  - 2021 shirt design and color is found below.
  - Shirts will be shipped directly from the apparel company to the shipping address designated in CVent registration. The preference is to ship to local Extension offices (business address). Coordinators need to confirm with their local Agent if they are shipping to a location other than the Extension Office.
  - Shirts will arrive before the State Match.
