



Pawnee County 4-H Spring Shootout

8:00 a.m. – March 16, 2024

Larned Community Center – 1500 Toles, Larned, Kansas (Air Rifle and BB)

J.A. Haas Exhibit Building – 403 E. 18th, Larned, Kansas (Air Pistol)

Pawnee County will be hosting a shooting sports match for Air Rifle, Air Pistol and BB. This match is a state qualifier. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4-H age 9-18. **Note: the minimum age to participate at the State Match is 9 years old before January 1, 2024. Air Pistol participants must be 12 years old. We will have an Air Rifle and BB Fun Shoot for 8-year-olds, if space allows.**

Air Rifle: Shooters will shoot 20 bull shots in each of 3 positions. Rules will follow the current CMP National Standard 3-position Air Rifle rulebook. Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in the following age groups: 9-12, 13 & over. Teams will be given to the top 3 teams overall. Everyone will shoot as an individual and Teams will be determined by top 4 scores from the county. Entries limited to 40. **To qualify for the State Match in air rifle, the minimum individual score is 450 and the shooter must be at least 9 years old by 01-01-2024.**

Air Pistol: Shooters will shoot 40 shots at 8 bulls (5 shots per bull) at 10 meters for a possible score of 400. Rules will follow the current NRA-USAS Progressive Air Pistol rulebook with the following divisions. Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in each age group: Juniors (13 and under) and Seniors (14+). Team awards will be given to the top 3 teams overall; teams will be determined by top 2 scores. A signed Hand Gun permission form must be on firing line with shooter. Entries limited to 16. **To qualify for the State Match in air pistol, the minimum individual score is 280 and must be at least 12 years old by 01-01-2024. Silhouettes will be shot.**

BB Gun: Shooters will shoot 10 shots in each of the 4 positions. Rules will follow the current Kansas 4-H State Match Rules, Daisy National Match Program Rules and NRA BB Gun rulebook. Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in each division in the following age groups: 9-12 and 13-15. Age groups may be adjusted after registration is received. Team awards will be given to the top 3 teams overall; teams will be determined by top 5 scores. Entries limited to 40. **To qualify for the State Match in BB gun, the minimum individual score is 335.**

To receive a T-shirt, Registration form and fees are due Wednesday, February 28, 2024 by 5 p.m.

No T-shirt and just match entry deadline is Friday, March 8, 2024 by 5 p.m. Please email registration form before mailing. Late entries will be accepted to fill relays but will NOT include a shirt. Fees are \$16.00 per shooter for the first discipline and \$8.00 for each additional discipline. Please send one entry form per county and the listed contact person will be notified of relay times. For Check-In, please plan to arrive at least 30 minutes before your first flight time. Each county needs to verify their shooters' information when checking in for correct age and disciplines. The shoot will begin at 8:30 a.m., starting with our county and the counties that touch us. This will allow us to complete the contest earlier in the day. Parents and coaches can also order shirts for \$14.00 each up to XL; \$15 each over XL. They must be pre-ordered on the Entry Form. We will use the Orion Scoring System for all: Air Rifle, Air Pistol and BB.

There will be a Concession Stand available.
