SUBJECT: Judging Schedule for 4-H Fashion Revue at the Kansas State Fair Saturday, September 17, 2022

On the [4-H State Fair Info Webpage](#), you will find the Judging Schedule for the Fashion Revue at the Kansas State Fair.

The Kansas State Fair 4-H Fashion Revue committee has worked extremely hard to make this year's 4-H fashion revue the best yet. We tried to schedule you as close as possible to the time that you requested. If you have a conflict that can't be resolved, you'll have to make a choice as to whether or not you can participate. We tried to accommodate time preferences and distance the best of our ability.

Judging will be held in the Stringer Fine Arts Center of Hutchinson Community College, 600 East 11th Avenue. It is located southeast of the Fairgrounds on 11th Street, two blocks east of the corner of 11th and Plum. Enter the building through the main entrance at the southeast corner. Parking is ample on the south or east side (same parking lot as for the Sports Arena). It is an air-conditioned building, and all on one floor. We must respect the following rules:

**No food or drink allowed *No smoking *Do not touch art exhibits *No running in halls*

Please arrive 30 minutes early and check-in at the appropriate registration table in the main lobby in front of the Recital Hall. If you are scheduled at 8:30 a.m., please do not arrive before 8:00 a.m. After checking in, you may change clothes to be ready to model 15 minutes ahead of your scheduled time. You will not need an entry card.

4-H members will be judged in groups within the time allowed. After judging, each contestant must go to the stage to practice for the public revue. Call backs will be announced before leaving the judging room. All purple ribbon winners will be call backs. If you are not a call back, you are free to leave when the judging and stage practice are completed.

We respectfully ask that only ONE additional person come to the Fine Arts Building with each 4-H member. They may assist in the dressing room, where appropriate, but cannot watch the judging. They will be asked to wait in the Recital Hall where the 4-H'ers will practice modeling for the public revue. Information about the public revue will be given at check-in. **Participants must take part in the public revue in order to receive ribbons.**

We will have two separate Public Revues and they will both be held in the 4-H Encampment Building Auditorium on the Kansas State Fairgrounds. The Constructed Revue will be at 4:00 p.m. and the Buymanship Revue will be held at 5:00 p.m. We are excited that we will have a 4-H Alumni/professional photographer at the public revue to take photos. You will be able to see and purchase photos online after the event.

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INSTRUCTIONS FOR FASHION REVUE JUDGING

Please read carefully the information below and bring these instructions with you the day of judging. If you have questions, please do not hesitate to ask anyone wearing a nametag.

Contestant Number

Each contestant will receive a contestant number when checking in for judging. Please place it on your left side, just below your fingertips. This number is to be worn during the judging and practice in the morning, but does not need to be worn during the public revue. However, you are asked to bring it with you to the public revue to help with line-up. PLEASE DO NOT MISPLACE YOUR NUMBER. This is the only one we have for you.

Instructions for Judging

Dressing Rooms: Please plan to be dressed and ready 15-20 minutes before your scheduled time. There will be one room for boys, and one room for girls. We may also be able to use rooms 147 and 148 for curling hair and applying make-up. These rooms are theatrical dressing rooms. They are fairly small, but have several mirrors and electrical outlets in them.

Line-up for Judging

After you are dressed, go directly to your assigned judging room and check-in with the person at the door. Please be sure to line-up in the judging order listed, not in numerical order.

Judging

You and your group will go into the judge's room together. You will individually model your outfit and briefly consult with the judge. After the group is finished being judged, you will all go directly to Room 114, the Recital Hall, and wait to be called to Recital Hall Stage to practice for the Public Revue. Everyone MUST practice.

Call Backs

As contestants leave the judging room, call backs will be handed a "call back" card. If you are not a call back, you may leave the building after you are finished practicing for the Public Revue. If you are a call back, you will need to return to your judging room after all the groups have been judged. Approximate times for judging call backs are as follows:

Constructed Garments – 11:30 a.m.

Young Women's Buymanship – 12 noon

Young Men's Buymanship – 11:00 a.m.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PUBLIC REVUE

Location and Time

The Public Fashion Revues, Clothing Construction is at 4:00 p.m. and Buymanship at 5:00 p.m., will be held, September 18, 2021 at the 4-H Encampment Building Auditorium, located on the Kansas State Fairgrounds.

Dressing Rooms for the Public Fashion Revue

Girls: 4-H Encampment Building – upstairs room off lobby area

Boys: 4-H Encampment Building – room across the hall from Encampment Office

Additional space may be available in the restrooms in the 4-H Encampment and Exhibit Buildings.

Personal items may be left in the dressing rooms but should not be left in restrooms.

Photographer

There will be a photographer in the line-up room and out in front of the stage. The order form is available where you downloaded schedules. In addition to ordering that day, you will be able to order online.

Line-up for Public Fashion Revue

You need to be responsible for getting to the 4-H Encampment Building Auditorium on your own.

Contestants for both Public Fashion Revues will line up in the Kansas Fairs Associations Exhibit Hall located in the 4-H Encampment Building down the first hallway to the right upon entrance into the Encampment Building.

Constructed Fashion Revue contestants will line-up at 3:30 p.m. for the 4:00 p.m. Public Fashion Revue.

Buymanship Fashion Revue contestants will line-up at 4:30 p.m. for the 5:00 p.m. Public Fashion Revue.

When you arrive at the 4-H Encampment meeting room, find the sign with the line-up list by contestant number. A committee member will be there to help you line-up and tell you when to go on stage.

Modeling

As you model, you will be going on stage in groups. Please do as instructed during the morning practice. Please position yourself comfortably, smile and wait for the narrator to read your script.

After You Have Modeled in the Public Revue

As you exit the stage, a committee member will be next to the stairs to hand you your ribbon and judge's comment sheet. If you were a call back, please stay where you can easily access the stage again. DO NOT BLOCK the view of the audience. If you were not a call back, you are free to view the remainder of the fashion revue where you find comfortable.

When the narrator reads the final description for your public revue, all call backs will be called to come back on stage for the presentation of the awards. It does not matter what order call backs re-enter the stage. Please do so in a timely manner.
