

KANSAS AND NATIONAL REQUIREMENTS OF LEVEL 2 TRAINING PARTICIPANTS:

- 21 years of age or older.
- Have State (Level 1) certification in the discipline in which they are enrolling
- Understanding that successful participants will return to become a member of their state teaching team where they will commit to teaching for at least 3 years.
- Have two years of teaching experience as a Level 1 instructor in the discipline.
- Have a strong understanding of 4-H and positive youth development.
- Endorse the train-the trainer concept in basic shooting skills.
- Must have previous experience teaching youth and/or adults in their state.
- Have current 4-H Volunteer status or Extension Faculty status in their state.
- Have thorough knowledge of the 4-H Shooting Sports Discipline manual in which they are seeking certification.
- Be well versed in the four Primers found in the shooting sports manuals which include: “Module 1 – What is 4-H”, “Module 2 – Introduction to 4-H Shooting Sports”, “Module 3 – Creating and Implementing a High-Quality Program”, “Module 4 – Risk Management: Covering your Assets”.
