FITA Course of Fire: Traditional FITA 10-ring targets. Practice will consist of 6 arrows at 40 meters (Seniors) and 6 arrows at 30 meters (Juniors) prior to compete on. Archers will have a total of 4 minutes to shoot each 6 arrow end. 2 minutes is allowed to look for lost arrows after each end.

Juniors: 12 arrows at 20 meters and 12 arrows at 30 meters. 6 arrows each end.

Seniors: 12 arrows at 30 meters and 12 arrows at 40 meters. 6 arrows each end.

Qualifying Scores required:

Recurve Bare Bow: 120 out of a possible 240

Recurve Olympic: 140 out of a possible 240

Compound Bow Hunter: 200 out of a possible 240

Compound Open: 210 out of a possible 240

Individual Awards will be given to the top 3 shooters each class.
