All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4-H ages 9-18. Juniors (9-13 years old) will shoot 12 arrows at 30 meters and 12 arrows at 20 meters. Seniors (14-18 years old) will shoot 12 arrows at 40 meters and 12 arrows at 30 meters.

Minimum Scores to Qualify for STATE:

Recurve -120 points out of 240

Olympic -140 points out of 240;

Bow Hunter/Compound - 200 points out of 240

Open/Compound - 210 points out of 240.
