This match is a state qualifier. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4-H age 12-18. Qualifier only, no awards.

**Registration forms are due by Monday, August 10.** Late registration is only accepted to fill relays. Fees are \$15. We will only accept registration from one person per county and this person will be notified of relay times. Fees will be paid on the day of event. Registration will begin at 8:30 a.m. – shooter's information will need to be verified when checking in. **No concessions will be available, but we will have water available.**

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**Course of Fire:** TG2406 target: shoot 10 shots at 50 yards; TG2427 bottle target: shoot 10 shots at 25 yards

**Qualifying score:** 75 points out of 200

**Rules:** We will follow the current NMLRA rules and the Kansas 2026 State Match Rules
