






Surveyed Staff and Families

- 46% of counties had advertised and recruited for face to face summer programs
- 15% were/had planned virtual programs
- 75% were unsure of virtual programs
- 23% considering grab and go boxes, 18% socially distanced face to face (6 hour), 18% zoom programs, 16% socially distanced face to face (under 6 hour) 10% Facebook, 10% Youtube
- 80% would welcome virtual attendees from other counties

- 50% wanted programs for 4-8th graders
- 31% wanted STEM programs
- 43% preferred hybrid learning format
- 63% preferred short term (30-60 min)
